The Petroleum Accountants Society of Canada (PASC) has a 50+ year history serving the needs of the energy industry.

Currently PASC is recruiting an instructor for our Introduction to Petroleum Accounting course, specifically on the subject of “Financial and Management Accounting.”

The course is a high level discussion of the various accounting roles within the industry, and the specialized knowledge required to maintain proper controls. Topics include:

- Accounting departments and their specific functions
- A brief introduction of Joint Venture contracts and their impact
- An overview of some petroleum economics and technologies
- An outline of revenues, expenses, and capital AFEs
- Full cost versus successful efforts
- Asset retirement obligations and ceiling tests
- IFRS, Canadian GAAP, amortizations, and financial statements
- Taxation at federal and local levels
- Characteristics of a suitable accounting system

Basic presentation materials are in place, but the instructor is expected to update the information as required. Each component includes overheads/slides, as well as associated notes.

Time Commitment

As part of a team, you will teach a half-day of a two day seminar that targets new entrants to our profession. Your services will be required twice annually, once each in the spring and fall.

Qualifications

The ideal instructor will be an accounting professional with a broad exposure to the resource industry. They should be comfortable with fielding questions and handling basic presentation equipment.

Compensation

PASC instructors are fully compensated at an equitable rate for both the instructing and maintenance of the course materials. Rate of pay is based on experience level.
