UPCOMING LUNCHEON: An Update on EPAP

Topic: Overview of the Enhanced Production Audit Program (EPAP)

Mr. Schulz will be discussing the EPAP based on his work leading the development of EPAP for the ERCB and his experience implementing EPAP at oil & gas operators. His presentation will touch on the who, what, when, where, why and how of the EPAP, and will also describe best practices for EPAP implementation that accelerate, risk-reduce and cost-contain EPAP implementation projects for oil & gas operators.

A current partner and founder of Corvelle Consulting, Mr. Schulz has nearly 30 years of Information Systems experience, of which 25 years has been spent as a consultant. He holds a B. Comm from the University of Calgary, is a member of CIPS and holds its ISP designation. Mr. Schulz also serves as a member of the Board of Directors of the Professional Petroleum Data Management Association.
