Mr. Haugen has over 20 years of experience in the upstream oil and gas industry in business and technical roles. He holds a Petroleum Engineering Degree from the University of Alberta and is a registered professional engineer in the Province of Alberta. He is also a member of the Society of Petroleum Engineers and the Executive Committee of the Canadian Natural Gas Vehicle Alliance.
